HOW STUDENTS CAN EARN AN ALASKA HUNTER EDUCATION CERTIFICATE

1. Parents register their children at <https://www.hunter-ed.com/alaska/sign-up/>
There is a 15.00 registration fee.

2. Students study and pass the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADFG) online course.

3. Sign up for and attend the ADFG field day.

Once the student completes the online course, parents print out the Field Day Qualifier Certificate, which students will need to bring with them to the Field Day. Parents need to locate and sign up their child for a Field Day. To sign up, go to <http://www.adfg.alaska.gov/index.cfm?adfg=huntered.main>

Special Note: Passing the online course does not guarantee you a spot at the Field Day.

Students will receive a permanent Hunter Education Certificate after successfully completing the Field Day. The Hunter Education Certificate will be mailed to you.

The hunter education course provides training in firearms safety, wildlife conservation, and respect for our natural resources, landowners, and other hunters. Graduates receive a lifetime certification recognized by all states, including Canadian provinces.
